DISCIPLINARY REGULATIONS

In this hostel training is give for **EDUCARE**, i.e. to bring out human qualities such as selfless love, sacrifice, forbearance, compassion etc., in each student. Hence every student is expected to **behave with a high sense of discipline** so that he may gain the real benefit of his stay in this hallowed Institution.

The following are **important guidelines for a happy and successful life** here.

1. As humility is the firm foundation for a noble character, each student is expected to practice sincerely, obedience and reverence to teachers and elders, mutual courtesy and love towards fellow students.
2. As silence is the **key to self-knowledge**, every student should voluntarily maintain silence during mass gatherings in places like dining hall, classroom, Mandir premises etc.
3. Students should not indulge in **loud and unnecessary talk**.
4. All students should wear decent and unostentatious dress and always maintain a **short and well groomed hairstyle**. The students are not expected to sport moustache, beard and long side burns.
5. Going outside the hostel premises for any reason other than attending School and Mandir will not be entertained. Overnight stay outside the hostel is forbidden,
6. Students are permitted to go home only during the winter and summer vacations. In the event of compelling situations such as for medical treatment, marriage (**own sister/brother**). The warden may permit a student to go home on receiving requisition letter from the parent.
7. Parents meet is allowed only on Sundays between 10 a.m. and 1 p.m. **and not on any other holiday or working day**. The local guardians and parents at Parthi are especially requested to co-operate in this regard. The ‘parents meet’ will be cancelled a week or two before the commencement of examination/unit tests to enable the students to concentrate on studies.
8. Students are permitted to have telephonic conversation between 6.45 to 7.45 hours in Morning and evening as shown below.

Monday..... VIII Class
Thursday..... XI Commerce
Friday..... XI Science
9. Parents are requested to restrict their telephonic conversation with the ward to a maximum of five minutes in view of many students waiting for their incoming calls.
10. The parents are requested **not to detain their ward in front of Ganesh temple in the Ashram** when the student is returning from Mandir to the Hostel as it **breeds indiscipline in the student**.

11. Students are permitted to read only such magazines like Wisdom, Bhavan's Journal, Frontline etc., which do not pollute or disturb young minds.
12. Students are **not allowed to possess** tape recorder or transistor, video games, cell phones etc. in the hostel.
13. Cleanliness is next to Godliness. Hence all students are required to **maintain high standard of personal cleanliness and cleanliness of room and the surroundings.**
14. (a) Parents are requested not to give any cash on hand to their ward except during the first week of the term. In other occasions, the parents should deposit the cash into the stores account of their ward for any kind of expenses

(b) Whenever students receive money from parents they have to **deposit the amount into their bank account/stores account without delay.** Students are not expected to keep much cash with them. When required, they can withdraw the money from their stores account after getting permission from their wing teacher.

(c) Every student should always bear in mind the following guidelines of Bhagawan for his happy life
"Don't waste time, **Time waste is life Waste**
Don't waste Food, **Food is God**
Don't waste money, **Misuse of Money is Evil**"
15. As spiritual development is essential for the blossoming of students personality **every student should participate in all spiritual practices with sincerity and true spirit of participation.**
16. The students should take proper care to maintain the furniture, cupboard and fixtures of the Hostel in good condition. In case of breakage or damage the student responsible for that should replace the same. The students are strictly prohibited from writing or sticking on the walls and cupboards.
17. As the Hostel life is a busy life, all the students should make effort to get up at 5.00 a.m everyday and go to bed after night prayers about 10 p.m.

Any breach of the hostel rules and regulations will be seriously viewed and a Student may be expelled both from the hostel and School at any time if his behavior is found unsatisfactory.
