INFORMATION FOR NEW ENTRANTS AND PARENTS

1. Every student should first read carefully the enclosed Hostel Regulations and then fill up the Hostel application form in his **own legible handwriting**.
2. Each student has to pay an annual amount of Rs.12,000/- to the hostel, the details of which are as follows:

Mess & Maintenance charges
(for the academic year 2010-2011) Rs.7500/-

Caution Deposit (refundable at the time of collecting TC) Rs. 500/-

Stores account (personal expenditure)
(This excludes the expenses for text books, note books and journey tickets) Rs. 2500/-

Note books and text books Rs.1500/-

The Deficit charges (if any) for the Mess and Maintenance charges will be collected from each student at the end of each term of 5 months.

3. Each student will be issued, once in week a 'credit card' (of value of Rs.50/- or Rs.100/- as per his requirement) on demand, by which he can get essential items from the hostel 'stores'. Any time, the student should keep a minimum of Rs.200/- as balance in his stores account for getting a new credit card. Every time this credit card amount will be deducted from his stores account
4. **Parents should keep track of their wards' expenditure in order that there is always positive balance in their stores account.**
5. Mode of Payment.

The total amount payable (for Mess charges and personal expenses amount) has to be paid into the Hostel's Current Account No. **30711322257** of State Bank of India through the appropriate challan enclosed herewith. After payment, the counterfoil copy should be produced in the hostel office at the time of joining the hostel. Payment by cash/cheque will not be accepted. No part payment will be received.

6. The Hostel dispensary will provide good and timely health care to the students. The services of the Sri Sathya Sai General Hospital and Sri Sathya Sai Super Speciality Hospital will be made available free of cost to any student on the recommendation of the Hostel Doctor.
7. Parents/ guardians should declare at the time of admission, whether their ward is suffering from any disease/ ailment that may affect the student community in the Hostel.
8. The parents have to get the initials of the name of the ward stitched as an identification mark on all the dress materials as also on sleeping materials.
9. **The parents are expected to meet the Warden and Wing Teacher of the ward at least twice in a year, any day between 12 noon and 1 p.m. to get the correct assessment about their ward.**
