INFORMATION FOR PARENTS OF NEW STUDENTS OF CLASS VIII, XI AND MUSIC BOYS

Your ward has to report at the school office on 4th June 2009 before 4 p.m. failing which the admission stands cancelled.

He should have secured minimum of 60% in each subject in the class X Public Examination. Admission will be confirmed after submission of the following certificates:

1. Marks sheet.
2. Pass certificate.
3. Migration Certificate (Other than CBSE schools).
4. Transfer Certificate (TC should be counter signed by DEO incase of those who are coming from boards other than CBSE).
5. Conduct Certificate.
6. Date of Birth Certificate.

The above mentioned certificates in original and a set of Xerox copies are required.

1. Every student should **first read carefully the enclosed Hostel Regulations** and then fill up the Hostel application form in his **own legible hand writing**.
 2. At the time of joining the Hostel each student has to pay the Hostel Annual Charges as detailed below.
 - i) For Mess and maintenance of Hostel for the Academic year 2009-2010 : Rs. 7,500/-
 - ii) For Caution Deposit : Rs. 500/-
 - iii) For Text Books and Note Books (VIII std) : Rs. 1000/-

3. The total Amount should be deposited in the Hostel's Current Account No. 30711322257 of State Bank of India through the appropriate challan (Yellow challan enclosed) available at the Bank. **The counterfoil of the challan after the payment should be produced to the Hostel office** at the time of admission. No payment in cash/cheque will be received in the Hostel office. **Part payments will not be accepted.**
4. For personal expenses each student will be issued, once in a week on demand a Debit card value of (Rs. 50/- or Rs.100/-) by which he can get necessary items from the Hostel General Stores and Fruit Stall.

5. The Personal expenses amount will be available for payment incurred for Dhobi/Barber charges, general stores, fruit stall, telephone etc.
6. The parents should make arrangements for the journey tickets whenever necessary:
7. **The Parents should keep track of their wards personal expenditure to ensure, there is always positive balance in their stores account.**
8. The Parents to **get the initials of the Name of the Ward stitched as an identification mark** on all the dresses and bedding material and other clothes.
9. The hostel dispensary will provide good and timely healthcare to the students. The services of the Sri Sathya Sai General Hospital and Sri Sathya Sai Super Speciality Hospital will be made available free of cost to any student on the recommendations of the Hostel Doctor.
10. The Parents/Guardians should declare at the time of admission if their ward is suffering from any disease or ailment that may affect the student community in the Hostel.
11. **The Parents/Guardian are expected to meet the Warden and the wing teacher at least twice in a year, any day between 12 noon and 1 p.m. to get the progress report about their ward.**
